FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

GATES OPEN: 2pm on Friday afternoon & 7am on both Saturday & Sunday mornings & will be closed at 10pm each evening.

Covid – 19 regulations apply for this meeting. Keep your distance, wear masks where needed and use hand sanitizer. You should bring your own PPE. Do not share any items, tools, leathers, helmets, gloves, boots or any other equipment. The pit bays must be at least 2 meters apart and only one family may share a pit area.

You will be required to register at the gate to comply with the attendance regulations. You can pre-register using the OR code sheet attached and complete the questionnaire. If you cannot use the QR code, you must sign the sheets at the gate. All people will be required to wear an armband to show they have completed the sign on procedure.

REGISTRATION is near the Race Secretary's office & commences at 7am.

THERE WILL BE TWO LINES FOR REGISTRATION (one for sign on and one for transponder pick up and Scrutineering cards)

DO NOT BRING YOUR BIKE TO REGISTRATION!

- **RHS**: Transponders
- LHS: Sign on.
- After you have registered & fitted your timing transponder you may proceed to scrutineering
- Timing transponders are to be fitted to the LHS (when you are sitting on the bike) on the forks as low as possible. All transponders will be checked for correct operation at scrutineering

SCRUTINEERING (Leathers & back protector should be worn, bring gloves, boots, helmet & Historic Logbooks) 7.30AM

RIDERS BRIEFING (Compulsory for all riders). A random roll call will be held. 9.30AM

ENGINE WARM UP: NOT BEFORE 9.45 AM ON BOTH SATURDAY & SUNDAY AFTER RIDER BRIEFINGS 9.45AM

RACING NUMBERS will be as you requested on your entry unless advised otherwise. No double ups of numbers in the one race will be allowed. Some numbers have been changed. Please check that yours is still ok.

PITS

are on natural ground. It is advisable to bring a tarp or carpet for the floor & your own marques etc. There are no covered pits. NO PARKING OF VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED ALONG THE PIT LANE ACCESS ROAD. SPECTATORS (NOT CAMPERS) ARE REQUESTED TO PARK IN THE DESIGNATED AREA ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF THE TRACK. ENTRANTS WHO WISH TO CAMP BESIDE THEIR PITS WILL HAVE TO SET UP AT THE REAR OF THE PIT AREA.



NOTE 1: THE FIRST 3 ROWS IN THE MAIN PIT AREA ARE DESIGNATED FOR 3M X 3M MARQUES ONLY, 3M X 4.5M OR 3M X 6M IF YOU HAVE AT LEAST 2 BIKES, (NO CARS OR TRAILERS ARE TO BE LEFT IN THIS AREA) ANYONE USING THESE LOCATIONS IS TO PARK THEIR CAR ALONG THE DIRT ACCESS ROAD & TRAILERS ARE TO BE PLACED ALONGSIDE YOUR VEHICLE OR AGAINST THE FENCE BEHIND THE TOILETS SHOWERS.

CAMPING

Is behind the Pits on Friday & Saturday nights. For Friday night camping, gates are open from 2pm on Friday afternoon. No generators are to be used between the hours of 10pm & 7am & no amplified music from 6pm till 7am. The local club have recently purchased a new toilet & shower block with hot showers for those wishing to brave the cold weather. These may not be in use due to Covid -19 regulations.

Rubbish bins are not to be used for lighting fires!

At the track operators request Noise must be kept to an absolute minimum!!!!!! after 9pm. No power or shower facilities are available at the track.

BE WARNED - Temperatures can be as low as 2 deg C overnight. Please bring warm bedding, clothing and waterproof camping gear. Thermals are advisable.
