

## MORGAN PARK TRACK RESURFACING

I attended the Morgan Park track day on Friday February the 17<sup>th</sup> & had a great day on my old FZR600. It's amazing what new tyres & tyres warmers can do for your lap times ( thanks to Al & Fish )

We used the 2.5km circuit "I" which is highlighted in orange below & which I have never raced on before. It was an extremely fun & challenging course particularly getting used to a sharp right hand turn just after the bridge ( turn 3 ) & the second or third gear left hand corner opposite where the normally rough section is at turn 8. I am led to believe that this is the track they are going to use for all events until they do some resurfacing in April this year.

The resurfacing is going to be done on turns 4, 6 & 7 through 10. If this work is completed successfully it will certainly make for a great track for the Masters of Morgan Park in May this year.

I believe these track days are a great way to get people interested in racing as we now have 5 guys just from Goondiwindi attending several track days a year. You get a lot of track time, usually 6 ten minute sessions per day & its great value for money. You can use a standard road bike or buy an old roughie like my FZR & have a ball. I introduced club member Allan Barter to racing this way & he in turn has helped encourage 3 others to get involved.
