Inaugural Event – 18th to 20th September 2009.

This event will be a cross country touring road rally, open to Italian motorcycles that are eligible for the following categories:

Vintage	pre 1958	Max Capacity 175cc
Classic	pre 1968	Max Capacity 250cc
Modern	pre 1978	Max Capacity 500cc

Motorcycles must be road registered, or have appropriate club plates. The event is to be conducted under the banner of the DOCO (Old) Inc.

This is an untimed road rally, in the spirit of the original Moto Giro (Italy) with the purpose of encouraging the use and display of classic Italian motorcycles in the stunning Sunshine Coast (Qld) hinterland region.

Based at Woodford, the event will commence with a welcome dinner on the Friday evening, allowing participants to get acquainted and establish their base for the weekend's riding. The rally will be officially started on the Saturday morning with a display and demonstration laps around the newly reopened Lakeside circuit, in conjunction with the Historic and Heritage Festival. Thereafter we will ride along selected routes through the scenic hinterland roads, with scheduled stops for meals and refreshments.

We return to Woodford for Saturday evening dinner, with a guest speaker and films of interest to Moto Giro participants.

Sunday will comprise further touring through the Sunshine Coast hinterland, with optional loops for those wishing to explore the area more fully. It is intended to share our lunch venue with the DOCQ ride day. The rally will end at Woodford on Sunday afternoon with a de-brief and presentation.

For each day's riding, a lead bike will head the parade with a sweep vehicle following should mechanical problems manifest themselves. All personal gear will be left at our Woodford accommodation.

Participants will receive a commemorative Tee-Shirt, riding number and rally souvenir. It is anticipated that this would become an annual event, subject to interest.
