
Camping will be available at the circuit at \$10 per head per night with indemnity forms and money to be collected at the circuit.

1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The HMRAV, hereafter called the PROMOTER, will conduct the SOUTHERN CLASSIC FESTIVAL for Historic Road Racing solos and sidecars at the State Motorcycle Complex, on the above date.

2.

- The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Victoria which has issued a Motorcycling Australia Permit Number as detailed above and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia NATIONAL LICENCES and INTERNATIONAL LICENCE holders. International licence holders need to approach MV no later than four (4) weeks before close of entry date to verify that all conditions for racing are met. International licence holders will require the applicable insurance cover including adequate repatriation insurance to the satisfaction of Motorcycling Australia prior to their race entry being accepted.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any further instructions approved by Motorcycling Victoria.
- BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND 2.3 INSTRUCTIONS.

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail Friday, 21st September, 2012. Late Entries may result in no / minimal trophies for each class.
- In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the HMRAV, if such retention 3.2. is approved by Motorcycling Victoria.
- Only entries received on the official Entry Form which is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted. 3.3.
- NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER 3.4. WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE HMRAV AND ALL WITHDRAWALS AFTER THE CLOSE DATE WILL HAVE AN ADMINISTRATION FEE DEDUCTED.
- INSURANCE: 4.
- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability for MA licence holders only.
- Ambulance insurance is compulsory for licensees. 4.2.
- IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS 4.3. INSURANCE.
- 5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

Pre-approved Ambulance service will be in attendance.

- 6. **ENTRY FEE:**
- Solos \$190. Sidecars \$200. All entry fees include insurance levy and cost of transponder. A refundable deposit of \$50 will be required for the 6.1. transponders. Please note deposit is only refundable if transponder is returned at the circuit.
- Payment by cheque or money order only. ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE 6.2. ENTRANT. Cancellations must be in writing and an administration fee of \$50 will be charged.
- Cheques and money orders are to be made payable to HMRAV Inc. 6.3.
- Please include a self addressed business sized stamped envelope for confirmation of entry and the issuing of entry passes and any 6.4. further instructions.

7. **ENTRY PASSES:**

Solo Entries will receive 3 passes per competitor and 1 vehicle pass.

Sidecar Entries will receive 4 passes per competitor and 2 vehicle passes. Entrants will receive 1 pass and 1 vehicle pass.

CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

VINTAGE [1920 -1945] - 125cc, 250cc, 350cc, 500cc, Unlimited SOLOS:

CLASS C [Pre 1951] - 500cc & 750cc SV [Hand change] Rigid Frame CLASSIC [1946-1962] - 125cc, 250cc, 350cc, 500cc & Unlimited

POST CLASSIC [1963-1972] - 125cc, 250cc, 350cc, 500cc, Unlimited and Thunderbikes

FORGOTTEN ERA [1973–1980] - 125cc, 250cc, 350cc, 500cc, 600cc and Unlimited.

SIDECARS: Vintage, Classic, Post Classic, Forgotten Era & F2 sidecar or three wheeler up to 1300cc.

Note: HMRAV has a 650cc Classic and 836cc Post Classic sidecar class trophy as well.

9. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Trophies will be awarded over four (4) legs of racing (2 on Saturday & 2 on Sunday). Trophies will for the Southern Classic Races only will be presented Sunday at the end of racing.

ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

10.1. To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 2 with special incentive trophies offered at the discretion of the HMRAV. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the HMRAV and subject to Motorcycling Victoria approval.

11. RACE FORMAT:

See the chart attached. Race Format is subject to change, and/or may vary due to class entry sizes.

MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for HISTORIC competition. All machines must be scrutineered by the designated MV official scrutineers. Recommend all riders wear riding gear to Scrutineering.
- 12.2. Any change of rider or machine must be done in writing to the Clerk of Course not less than 30 minutes prior to the relevant race.
- 12.3 RÉSERVE RIDERS can only ride if the primary rider has retired completely from the event, unless a separate entry fee is paid.
- **RIDING NUMBERS:**
- 13.1. Where ever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the HMRAV"s discretion.
- All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR's. 13.2.

GRID POSITIONS:

For historic machines, grid positions for all weekends racing will be decided on times during practice / qualifying session on Saturday. Riders are responsible for knowing their grid positions.

15. RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A Riders' Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing at 8:30am each day and ALL competitors MUST attend and sign to this effect at the Riders' Briefing.

DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 16.1. All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 16.2. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended that competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the prize award may be delayed at the Motorcycling Victoria's discretion until the results of the tests are known.

CODE OF CONDUCT: 17.

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced. Riders being rude to officials may be excluded from the meeting.

18. TIMETABLE:

Scrutineering from 7:30am on Saturday and Sunday if required. Riders' briefing will be at 8:30am Saturday 20th October and Sunday 21st if required. Practice will start at 9:00am each day.

For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 8:00am with the completion of the meeting being when the last participant has vacated the circuit.

CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

Broadford has a length of 2.164 km, runs clockwise and has a bitumen surface.

20. STARTS:

Will be by clutch when the red lights go out.

21. RACING:

Machine examination 7:30am to 9:30am. Riders' Briefing 8:30am. Practice will start at 9:00am in 6 minute blocks. The RACE SECRETARY will have a chart with full details and times. The proposed practice will be as per the program.

NOISE: 22

All machines must meet the requirements and not exceed 95dc(a) at 30 meters. Meters will be in operation.

- ADMISSION CHARGES: Weekend \$25 single, \$30 family. Saturday \$10 single, \$20 family. Sunday \$15 single, \$25 family.
- UNATTENDED CHILDREN ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENTS.
- NO ANIMALS, WITH THE EXEMPTION OF GUIDE DOGS, ARE PERMITTED WITHIN THE STATE MOTOR CYCLE COMPLEX. RIDERS WHO BRING ANIMALS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE MEETING
- UNREGISTERED VEHICLES. Unregistered vehicles / bicycles and scooters not entered in competition may not be used at a permitted event unless authorised by the Clerk of Course and under official supervision. Bicycles and/or scooters will be confiscated until the meeting ends.
- 24.5 FACILITIES ETC. Gates will be open all night on Friday evening but may be locked at 8:30pm Saturday evening for security purposes. Contact with the Circuit Staff will need to be made to gain entry after this time. Food and beverages will be available at the circuit Saturday and Sunday. Breakfast will be available Sunday morning.

Pit Sheds are all allocated, 1st in best dressed. You will be advised if you have received a pit shed when you receive your passes.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS
