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#### 1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Queensland Early Motorcycle Sports Club Incorporated, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the QEMSC **TEST & TUNE** Event at Carnell Raceway, Stanthorpe, Qld on Saturday, and Sunday 18th & 19th of **July 2020**. For classes of events please see below.

#### 2. SPECIAL NOTE: COVID-19 COMPLIANCE.

- 2.1 This event is being run and **MUST** comply with the regulations set out in [the Motorcycling Queensland COVID Safe Plan available here](#).
- 2.2 **ALL attendees to this event Must sign the attendance record. This includes riders and others who accompany them. The riders are responsible to ensure others with them sign on. Maintain physical distancing of 1.5m minimum.**
- 2.3 **There is no paragraph 2.3. Wash your hands!**
- 2.4 **All people attending MUST bring their own PPE supplies, Face masks, hand sanitizer, gloves, and paper towels for their personal use. No sharing of equipment, tools, leathers, helmets, boots, or gloves permitted.**

#### 3. JURISDICTION

- 2.1 The abovementioned event has been authorised by Motorcycling Queensland who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number????????? and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior National & Recreation Licences.
- 2.2 The event will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCRs), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by Motorcycling Queensland.  
**BY ENTERING THIS EVENT ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS, AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

#### 3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 Entries open forthwith and close at last mail on **Friday 10th JULY 2020**.
- 3.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the event, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling Queensland.
- 3.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4 **RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE EVENT WILL BE CONSIDERED ONLY IF NOTIFICATION IS GIVEN PRIOR TO THE EVENT.**

#### 4. ENTRY FEE

- 4.1 An entry fee of **\$70 per day** and **\$120.00** for both days will be charged. **Recreation licences will NOT be available on the day. You will have to log on to Ridernet and purchase them at a cost of \$35 before you turn up at the track.** Full payment **MUST** accompany the entry form. **LATE ENTRIES MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

4.2 **PAYMENT.** Can be made by cheque, money order, PayPal or EFT. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONoured CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT. DO NOT SEND CASH THROUGH THE MAIL. 4.3 **TIMING.**  
There will be no timing at this event.

5. **CLASSES.**  
Classes will depend on type, quantity and capacity of riders and machines entered for this event

## 6. CLASSES AND CATEGORIES.

Class A	Sidecars. (All)
Class B	Novices. (Slow).
Class C	Intermediate. (Medium).
Class D	Solo Race machines only. (If I say it is, it is. No argument. You will NOT go out with the road bikes.)
Class E	Solo Road bikes only. (Fast).

## TRACK LIMITATIONS.

**These are listed on the Track licence.**

Historic sidecars – Period 3 all capacities

Historic sidecars – Period 4 all capacities

Historic sidecars – Period 5 all capacities

Historic Period 2 – Pre-1946 solos up to 1300cc

Historic Period 3 – Pre-1963 solos up to 1300cc

Historic Period 4 – 1963 to 1972 solos up to 500cc four stroke multis and 650 cc twins

Historic Period 5 – 1973 to 1982 solos up 350cc two stroke, 500cc four stroke multis, 650cc twins and 1000cc singles.

Historic Period 6 – 1983 to 1990 solos up 350cc two stroke, 500cc four stroke multis, 650cc twins and 1000cc singles.

**Any non-historic bikes will be considered by the promotor. Any decision will be final, and no discussion will be entered into.**

## 7. INSURANCE

7.1 MA's National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability only.

7.2 **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS SHOULD CONSIDER TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

## 8. MEDICAL SERVICES

**An ambulance will be in attendance between 9am–5pm on Saturday and 9am–3pm Sunday.**

**Interstate riders should ensure that they have Ambulance cover in their home state which is reciprocal with Queensland.**

## 9. AWARDS:

**NO AWARD OR PRIZES WILL BE HANDED for this event.**

11. **EVENT FORMAT.** Final ride format will be based on entries received and will be decided after close of entries. The split of events between Saturday and Sunday (i.e. number of events each day) will be decided before the event but will still be at the discretion of the **Event secretary.**

## 12. MACHINES AND RIDERS

12.1 All machines entered in this event must comply with the 2018 MOMS & the GCRs for **Historic Road Racing. All bikes will be self-scrutineered. Complete the form and hand it in at sign on.** Take note of the following:

12.2 All modern machines front and rear brake callipers to be lock wired in the tightened position.

12.3 All P4, P5, & P6 & modern machines must have engine end cases fitted as per MOMS.

12.4 Spare machines must be entered and scrutineered.

12.5 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class is not permitted.

12.6 Road machines will be assessed by the scrutineer and must pass his safety inspection. All mirrors **MUST** be removed and stands wired up. All glass **MUST** be taped or removed.

12.7 Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet always. **This includes while push starting any solos or sidecar.**

12.8 It is expected that all riders have a suitable fire extinguisher available in their pit area. Riders using methanol **MUST** provide a suitable water supply in case of fire.

## 13. RIDING NUMBERS

No numbers are required for this event.

## 14. GRID POSITIONS

**No grid positions are required.**

## 15. RIDERS BRIEFING

A riders briefing may be held prior to the commencement of racing on both days and **ALL riders MUST** attend if required. Any riders failing to attend riders briefing may be excluded from the event. Riders Briefing is a Non-Smoking Area.

## 16. DRUG AND/OR ALCOHOL TESTING

- 16.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any event in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 16.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506.

## 17. CODE OF CONDUCT

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law – CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced.

## 18. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

Carnell Raceway is approximately 1 km in length. Its surface is constructed of hot mix bitumen. Racing will be conducted in a clockwise direction. Push starting of machines in pit lane will only be allowed in a northerly direction (towards the dummy grid)

## 22. NOISE

- 22.1 ALL MACHINES MUST COMPLY WITH A 95db RIDE BY TEST AT 30M FROM THE EDGE OF THE TRACK. ANY MACHINES DETECTED TO BE OVER THIS LEVEL WILL BE UNABLE TO COMPETE UNTIL THE NOISE IS REDUCED TO THE ACCEPTABLE LEVEL. **See MOMS 9.12, appendix C, pages 245 – 249.**
- 22.2 **THIS FACILITY HAS A COMPLETE NOISE CURFEW FROM 10PM UNTIL 7AM IN WHICH NO GENERATORS CAN BE USED & NO AMPLIFIED MUSIC BETWEEN 6PM & 7AM.**

## 23. GST N/A

## 24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS

- 24.1 **COVID-19 rules apply for this event. All riders and their other attendees are expected to sign on and comply with directions from the appointed Safety Officers. Maintain physical distancing. (1.5m minimum). You and your companion will be expected to sign the attendance register at the gate BEFORE you enter. The rider must still sign on.**
- 24.2 Protective Clothing shall be worn as per GCRs 9.8, Appendix A, Pages 239 & 244
- 24.3 Scrutineering will be by the riders on the form attached to the entry form.
- 24.4 All riders will be responsible for scrutineering their own bikes. **The scrutineer will be performing checks over the weekend. You will be excluded from events until your machine meets the MOMS/Scrutineers requirements.**
- 24.5 **Restrictions: under no circumstances should ANYONE with symptoms consistent with Covid-19 attend the circuit. This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of sense of smell or fatigue. Under no circumstance should anyone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days or been in contact with a known Covid-19 positive person or person who has been overseas in the last 14 days, attend the circuit.**
- 24.6 FUEL: is not available at the track.
- 24.7 ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE PIT AREA DURING COMPETITION HOURS. RIDERS CONTRAVENING THIS RULE WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE DAY'S EVENTS.
- 24.8 CHILDREN ON WHEELED DEVICES OF ANY KIND ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA. These devices will be confiscated and returned at close of racing. CHILDREN UNDER 16 YEARS OF AGE ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE PIT LANE.
- 24.9 **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED WITHIN THE CIRCUIT GROUNDS AT ANY TIME.**
- 24.10 The promoter recommends that all competitors have a suitable fire extinguisher.
- 24.11 Any last-minute changes to the classes will be announced at the track and are dependent on entries received for each class.

- 24.13 ALL NOVICE OR FIRST TIME RIDERS ARE ASKED TO BRING A WHITE T-SHIRT TO WEAR OVER THEIR LEATHERS TO MAKE IT EASIER FOR FASTER RIDERS TO IDENTIFY YOU.
- 24.14 **Entry acceptance letters will NOT be sent out prior to this event. DO NOT SEND A SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE WITH YOUR ENTRY.**
- 24.15 **Maintain physical distancing of at least 1.5 metres.**
- 24.16 **Camping at the track will be permitted on Friday (from 4pm) & Saturday night.** A strict noise curfew will be enforced at 9pm each evening
- 24.17 **There should be a clear area between each marquee/pit bay of at least two metres. Or every second pit bay. Maintain physical distancing at all times.**
- 24.18 Carnell Raceway address is Rifle Range Rd, Stanthorpe Qld.
- 24.19 **DIRECTIONS TO TRACK:** From the north drive through the CBD & take the second left after the bridge (Sugarloaf road, blue sign to refuse tip). Take second right after railway line which is Rifle range Rd. Drive down Rifle Range Rd for about one kilometre, past the tip until it goes to dirt & you will see a yellow sign on for Carnell Raceway.

## CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE QEMSC Test & Tune Event

**WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS, PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.**

**1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below): [Insert Name]**

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

**2. DEFINITIONS** In this declaration:

- a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

**3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS**

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
  - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
  - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
  - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
  - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
  - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
  - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
  - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
  - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

**4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)**

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

**NOTE:** The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross

negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.

For the purposes of the clause 3, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Indemnitees.

**5. INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS**

IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting:

- a) I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following manner:
  - i) that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
  - ii) that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
  - iii) that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.

- d) A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

**6. MEDICAL**
